

NOTES

An early pivotal moment as a winemaker was experiencing the beauty of a then eight-year-old bottle of Chave Hermitage Blanc in the Spring of 2007 in the backyard with bread, cheese, and some figs. One dip of the nose into that glass brought on the tears - really - and a couple of glasses later, the decision to find a suitable vineyard and start making Roussanne that year was made. Seven years on, 2014 Three Sketches of a Dream is an homage to that experience. (Less than 50 cases produced, this is a Sanguis wine Society members only selection)

Vitals: Roussanne from three different vineyard sections, vilified with partial skin contact (because Roussanne skins are delicious), bottled in late 2016 and under lock and key 'til now, with the intent of providing you with a similar experience. The heady honeyed, heather-meadow aromas that define Three Sketches bear an uncanny resemblance to that inspirational bottle, but with more richness and intensity that is to be expected from California-born Roussanne. This is a wintry white if ever we made one, and while probably delicious in another 5-8 years, kind of begs to be opened and consumed right about now.

Food: Your favorite cheese and sourdough, dried or fresh figs and walnuts...Or, a hearty winter stew and a peppery arugula salad
